ONBOARDING

1 CREDENTIALS

For consideration as a Volunteer Health Provider with MCGPFC, applicants must complete a credential application, which may be provided by the Administrative Assistant or via email.

2 COMMUNICATION

Approved physicians will be added to the MCGP Clinic Whatsapp group chat, which serves as the primary platform for communication regarding scheduling, events, updates, and other operations.

3 CLINIC ORIENTATION

- Approved physicians will be scheduled for an orientation of the MCGPFC with the Administrative Assistant, which includes a tour of the clinic space.
- Clinic Operations/Protocols
 - Receive clinic office and exam room codes
 - Establish talkEHR account
 - Share the physicians manual and review clinic procedures
- Physicians must provide their NPI number to facilitate the laboratory service process.
- Physicians must bring their own prescription pads for appointments. MCGPFC highly recommends keeping prescription pads on file if desired.



PROVIDER SCHEDULING

VHPs are scheduled on a rotating basis.

- Primary Care: Friday evenings 7 pm-9 pm
 1st Sunday of the month 11am-2pm
- Specialty care:
 - Rheumatology: Wednesday & Friday 1pm-1:30pm
 - Cardiology: Third Wednesday of the month 7:30pm-9pm

Social Services/Counseling: Monday & Friday 11am - 3pm

*By appointment only. Thursday 11am - 6pm

The monthly calendar is posted to the MCGPFC WhatsApp group chat. The VHP scheduled for clinic coverage will receive a reminder from clinic staff at least a day in advance and will be sent the appointments scheduled.

*Please note: Understandably, personal situations may arise when VHPs on schedule may not be available to cover the office on their scheduled day; however, it is the responsibility of the VHP to find a substitute. It is recommended to post your request in the WhatsApp groupchat.

CLINIC POLICIES

ATTENDANCE

In the event that a provider is unable to keep a scheduled clinic date, they must notify the Administrative Assistant at least 2 days in advance with the name and contact information of their substitute/reliever.

Providers are encouraged to arrive 15 minutes before the first scheduled appointment. Kindly notify the administrative assistant beforehand if you will be arriving late.

DOCUMENTATION

All interactions must be properly documented at the MCGP Clinic. Providers must use the talkEHR system for documentation.

CLINIC OFFICE

Clinic office and exam room codes should not be shared with non-staff members. Any equipment used during appointments should be sanitized and placed back where they were found. Clinic staff will repair/replace any malfunctioning equipment.

PATIENT PRIVACY

Providers seeing patients are strongly encouraged to hold encounters in the clinic office and keep the clinic door closed during appointments.

COMMUNICATION

Any questions or concerns regarding clinic policies and procedures can be directed to Dr. Mustafa, Dr. Qazi, or Administrative Assistant Hakim.

MEDICATIONS/PHARMACY



- VHPs may give any medicine that is stored in the supply cabinet in our clinic office.
- For medications not offered at the clinic office, VHPs may write a prescription.

We plan to provide Medicines for chronic diseases like Heart Failure, Diabetes Mellitus, Coronary Artery Disease, Hypertension and Common Infections. Medical Home Pharmacy has agreed to dispense these medicines to our patients.

Following is the list of the medicines covered.

1. Congestive Heart Failure

Furosemide 40 mg Lisinopril 5, 10 and 20 mg Digoxin 125 Mcg Carvedilol 6.25 mg Spironolactone 25 mg Metoprolol 25, 50 mg

3. Coronary artery disease

Aspirin 81 mg Clopidogrel 75 mg Nitroglycerine 0.4 mg Isosorbide Dinitrate 20 mg Simvastatin 20 mg Isosorbide mono 30 mg

2. Hypertension

Amlodipine 5, 10 mg Diltiazem 30, 60 mg Clonidine 0.1, 0.2 and 0.3 mg Hydralazine 50 mg

4. Common Infections

Amoxicillin 500 mg Levofloxacin 500 mg Z pack

5. Diabetes Mellitus

Metformin 500 mg Glimepiride 2, 4 mg Glipizide 5, 10 mg

LABORATORY SERVICES



MCGPFC has an agreement with MedLife Diagnostics for free labwork to our clients. Labwork is limited to services indicated on our flyer.

Lab Service Protocol:

- Patients who request lab work must be scheduled for an appointment with MCGPFC.
- VHPs can check the specific lab services requested on the lab script, and include their NPI number and signature. VHPs must also provide the client with a completed State of New Jersey prescription blank.
- Patients will take scripts to the offsite MedLife Diagnostics location and obtain the tests needed. Test results are available through the MedLife Diagnositcs client portal.
- Patients can schedule a follow-up visit to review the results with a VHP.
 Suggested donations for affording patients is \$50/visit

NUTRITION SERVICES

Ms. Maimoona Manzar, RDN is a Dietitian/Nutritionist who collaborates with the MCGP Free Clinic to provide services to the community. Once a month, wellness lectures are held to educate and empower individuals around their diet, eating habits, and encourage healthier food alternatives.

VHPs can refer patients for nutrition counseling with Ms. Manzar on Saturday mornings (must make an appointment).

INTERPRETER SERVICES

VHPs looking for interpretation services to communicate with patients can use the Quantel Translator Services line. Quantel offers a variety of languages and operates 24/7.

INTERN SHADOWING

Our clinic offers a non-paid internship opportunity to high school and college students to volunteer. Volunteer hours can be earned towards fulfilling community service obligations.

Intern responsibilities can include patient triage, scribing, and shadowing as permitted by the VHP.

SOCIAL SERVICES + PSYCHIATRY

Ms. Raheela Hussain MSW, LSW collaborates with the MCGP Free Clinic and the MCGP Zakat (charitable giving) Committee to provide counseling to clients and connect them with various local services and resources.
